



ACTIVITY / TEACHER INSTRUCTIONS:

Headlines Instructions

OPTION 1

1. Separate students into six groups.
2. Give each group the Headline packet.
3. Each group must decide which fundamental principle they've learned about matches each headline and explain why.
4. Discuss as a group afterwards. Students may choose different principles for each one or think that more than one principle applies. The goal is that students are able to explain their choices.

OPTION 2

1. Separate students into six groups.
2. Give each group one headline. Explain that they will read the headline and decide which principle it relates to and why.
3. After time is up, have each group reports their headline and the principle they chose and why.

Allow other groups to agree or disagree with them.
