ACTIVITY / TEACHER INSTRUCTIONS: Headlines Instructions

OPTION 1

- 1. Separate students into six groups.
- 2. Give each group the Headline packet.
- 3. Each group must decide which fundamental principle they've learned about matches each headline and explain why.
- 4. Discuss as a group afterwards. Students may choose different principles for each one or think that more than one principle applies. The goal is that students are able to explain their choices.

OPTION 2

- 1. Separate students into six groups.
- 2. Give each group one headline. Explain that they will read the headline and decide which principle it relates to and why.
- 3. After time is up, have each group reports their headline and the principle they chose and why.

Allow other groups to agree or disagree with them.
