# Preamble Scramble Instructions

1. Print out each of the Preamble cards.
2. Shuffle and place face down on a table.
3. Students will take turns flipping over two cards. The goal is to find the statement from the Preamble along with its meaning. The student/group able to collect the most matches wins the game.
4. If played in teams, each turn a different student will represent the team.
5. In order to collect the match, the student who flipped the cards must say I have a match. If they are correct, they get to keep the match. If they are wrong, the student/team will lose their next turn. (This is to prevent students from saying it every time.)
